### **2026 Floor wages - Fairtrade Standard for Flowers and Plants, requirement 3.2.1**

Dear Fairtrade partners,

The Standards and Pricing Unit of Fairtrade International would like to notify you that in June 2025 the World Bank updated the global poverty line from US\$2.15 to US\$3.00 per day. In order to align with this update and support workers through the resulting wage adjustments, Fairtrade is adopting the revised poverty line and offering companies a phased implementation to meet requirement 3.2.1 of the [Fairtrade Standard for Flowers and Plants](#). The first increase will take effect on **1 August 2026**.

In line with this approach, the S&P Unit has published the 2026 floor wages. Please refer to the explanatory document [Calculating floor wages in the Fairtrade Standard for Flowers and Plants](#) for full details and the applicable floor wages.

Floor wages are updated annually following the procedure described in the [Standard Operating Procedure for Wage Floors Calculation](#).
