QUIZ ANSWERS FOR PRIMARY SCHOOLS: TRUE OR FALSE!

True or false! This quick-fire quiz is a fun way to get your students thinking about cocoa, the climate and Fairtrade. Use it as a stand-alone activity or as a starter for a full lesson from the 'Fairtrade Climate and You' Education Pack.

OUIZ

- 1. Chocolate bars are made from beans

 Chocolate bars <u>are</u> made from beans, but not baked beans! Chocolate is made from **cocoa beans!** Find out about cocoa production in the film 'Guardians of the Rainforest'.
- 2. Cocoa trees grow in the desert FALSE

 The desert would be too dry for cocoa beans to grow. Cocoa trees grow best in the rainforest.
- 3. Chimpanzees love the taste of cocoa Chimpanzees love the taste of sticky, sweet cocoa beans. Watch 'Guardians of the Rainforest' to find out how the farmers stop their pesky neighbours from eating their crops!
- 4. Cocoa trees grow best in freezing temperatures FALSE Cocoa trees grow well in warm temperatures, from 20-32 degrees Celsius.
- 5. All humans need healthy food to live

- 6. All humans need a car to live FALSE
 A car is something that is nice to have, but it is not a basic human need. Learn about wants and needs in the lesson plan 'Basic Needs: Lesson 1'.
